The DfE Screen for Fragrances

The Fragrances Technical Committee has agreed to strive to finalize the human health criteria for the fragrances screen by 15 June and hopes to begin implementing the human health criteria portion of the screen by 01 July. The environmental toxicity and fate criteria are still under development and will be combined and implemented with the human health criteria when finalized. We are developing the CleanGredients fragrances module so that we can begin accepting listings from fragrance suppliers as soon as possible once the human health criteria portion of the screen is available for implementation.
